1	Mood boards	a collection of physical or digital images, promoting generation of ideas
2	Mind maps/spider diagrams	shows connected ideas and thoughts about a planned project
3	Visualisation diagrams	a drawing, sketch or plan of how a final product will look
4	Storyboards	step by step scenes of what will happen in a play, video or animation
5	Scripts	the word for word dialogue in a play

6	Mood board content	images, colours, text and other assets. Physical boards can contain fabrics
7	Mind maps/spider diagram content	main theme or idea in the centre, with other ideas branching outwards
8	Visualisation diagram content	gives an impression of what the final product will look like. Can include annotations, fonts, images, logos and colours
9	Storyboard content	numbered scenes, camera directions, locations, scene durations and lighting.
10	Script content	contains dialogue; spoken parts of a final product. Will also include scene location, camera directions and background
		sounds/sound effects
Pre-Production Document Common Uses		
11	Mood board uses	used to suggest the themes and styles of the proposed product.
12	Mind maps/spider diagram uses	to develop ideas at the planning stage
13	Visualisation diagram uses	suited to plan static design work such as pages of a website, posters and DVD/game covers.
14	Storyboard uses	can see the flow of scenes, into each other
15	Script uses	scripts are used to plan any product that includes spoken parts; (videos, animations and audio)
