3	lianas	woody creepers, rooted to the ground. carried by trees into canopy	
4	epiphytes	air plants. These live in branches high in the canopy to seek sunlight	
5	leaching	heavy rainfall dissolving and carrying away nutrients from within the soil	
6	subsistence farming	sustainable small-scale farming, where people grow enough food to eat	
7	shifting cultivation	land is cultivated for a short period of time, then left to rejuvenate	
8	slash and burn	land cleared by fire which returns nutrients into the soil to help plants grow
