2. Minimalist composers	Terry Riley, Phillip Glass, Steve Reich, John Adams-all Americans
3. music cells	small rhythmic or melodic phrases
4. ostinato	a repeating pattern
5. arpeggio	a chord which is broken into individual notes
6. chord	more than 2 notes played at the same time
7. crotchet	a one beat note
8. quaver	a half beat note
9. semibreve	a four-beat note
10. flat	lowers the pitch by a semitone
11. glissando	a slide between notes
12. orchestrate	choose which instruments should play which parts
13. pulse	a regular beat
14. tempo	the speed of a piece
15. diatonic	can be major and minor scale
16. texture	layers of sound
17. metronome	a device used to keep the time via a regular tick
18. TAB	A way of demonstrating music for guitarists or ukulele players
19. elements of music	words used to describe music e.g. rhythm, metre, dynamics, timbre, texture
20. riff	a short repeated catchy pattern
