1. Rock	a form of popular music that evolved from rock and roll and pop music during the mid and late 1960s
2. Glam Rock	theatrical and glitzy form of Rock, catchy hooks, spangly suits and make up e.g. David Bowie, Queen
3. vocal range	the range of pitches the voice can create e.g. soprano, alto, tenor, baritone, bass
4. music genre	a Style of music
5. Hard Rock	a loud and aggressive form of Rock, distorted guitars, solo guitar sections, use of power chordse.g. Guns and Roses, Led Zeppelin
6. rhythm	a strong, regular repeated pattern of sound
7. melody	the tune
8. chord	more than one note played at the same time
9. instrumentation	the choice of instruments used
10. texture	layers of sound
11. dynamics	the volume
12. performer	a person who entertains an audience
13. semitone	the smallest interval e.g. C to C#
14. fretboard	part of the guitar where you create the notes, the metal frets are placed in semitone steps
15. Heavy Metal	harder, louder and more distorted than Hard Rock style with longer more virtuosic guitar solos e.g. Black Sabbath, Iron Maiden
16. drum kit	a kit which includes Crash/ride cymbal, floor tom, bass drum, mounted toms, Hi Hat cymbals, snare,
17. Progressive Rock	experimental and complicated style of Rock which has long instrumentals with effects e.g. Pink Floyd, Yes
18. chord	more than one note played at the same time
19. improvise	to create something on the spot
20. music engineer	is responsible for the technical part of a music recording.e.g. recording, editing, mixing
