

STANCHESTER ACADEMY – USE OF THE CATCH UP PREMIUM

The Literacy and Numeracy Catch-Up Premium gives schools additional funding to support Year 7 students who did not achieve at least a Level 4 in reading or mathematics at the end of Key Stage 2 (KS2).

The Year 7 Catch-Up Premium allocations for academic years 2013 to 2014, 2014 to 2015 and 2015 to 2016 are based on £500 for each Year 7 student recorded on the October school census and recorded in the Key Stage 2 assessment data as not having achieved Level 4, 5 or 6 in reading and / or mathematics.

Maths catch up 7 tuition, 4 hours per fortnight (teacher – SLT). 15 students started including 4C boys – identified as a group who historically have underperformed	£3,800	27% achieved Level 4 by Easter 2015 and ceased intervention. A further 47% achieved Level 4 by the end of Year 7. In Year 8 only 1 student is not achieving within GCSE framework grading.
Maths catch up 8, 7 hours per fortnight (teacher – SLT) – 14 students throughout the year	£6,650	43% are achieving within grade 2 of the GCSE framework and 0% of students are below the framework – this is the first time this has occurred at Stanchester.
English catch up 7, 7 hours per fortnight (SENCo), group of 8 students	£5,320	Every student increased their reading age through the additional reading support programme. Information has been shared with staff on readability for these students who are high need SEN. Evidence from

		reading support help to secure EHCP for 1 student.
Lexia Reading programme 1:1, 3 sessions of 20 mins per fortnight	£3000 + £390 LSA cost	Programme is costly and will be replaced by Nessie for the next academic year.
Individual support for basic skills maths and English – 4 students 1 hour per week, 2 x 10 week blocks each	£800	Students have regularly revisited the basic skills of numeracy required to achieve a grade within GCSE – 100% of students (not including student with ECHP) are achieving within the GCSE maths framework ensuring 100% A*-G continues to be achieved within maths.
Additional maths support - 1 hr p/w x 6 students year 8 (SENCo) – 2 x 10 week block	£800	Weakest students who attended catch up maths as a minimal low set (see above) received an additional hour per week to re-visit skills, embed and pre-learn.
LSA support for maths catch up group – 2 x LSA (1 supporting level 2 and 1 supporting level 3)	£1330	Support within the catch up 7 group enabled the students to learn at the pace correct for them and ensured close liaison for additional maths support hours and consolidation of skills 1:1 with LSAs when required.
Catch up 7 reading group with LSA 1hr p/w for 2 students	£380	Students now working within the new GCSE framework grades due to improvement in SPAG and reading.
Fresh start reading materials	£1000	Enabled students to learn through an identified and measurable reading and writing scheme.
